 with the resources necessary to succeed. This action-oriented team will utilize the
 technological and analytical tools already available to identify struggling students, triage
 their needs, offer differentiated care, and refer students to the appropriate office or

 share information with each other—including early alerts, predictive analytics, and

 - o 2-Year Transfer Graduation Rate: 50%. Current performance: 30%.
