She oversees the offices of Academic Program Quality and Institutional Knowledge Management, as well as serving as the Accreditation Liaison to the SACS Commission on Colleges. Her umbrella of activities includes leadership for SACSCOC reaffirmation and program review, university accountability tracking, student predictive analytics initiatives, decision-support information, and state and federal reporting.

Some of her current projects include serving as the lead for the PBF and Preeminence Strategy Executive Team, fostering new program development (new programs approved in 2018: 3 doctoral programs, 1 master, and 2 bachelors), supporting the Board of Trustees and Board of Governors on education-related items. Externally, she represents UCF through student-success focused consortia including the University Innovation Alliance, Frontier Set, and the Central Florida Educational Ecosystem Database.

Active and respected in her field, Borden is an elected Board member for the national Association for Institutional Research. Currently in year two of a three-year appointment, she also serves the Board as chair for the Future of Institutional Research committee and Parliamentarian. In prior years, Borden has also been a two-year member of the executive board of the Southern Association for Institutional Researchers as Treasurer, and was a two term President for the Florida Association for Institutional Research.

Dr. Borden has a Doctorate in Higher Education Leadership and an MBA, both from the University of Central Florida, and twenty-seven years of experience in higher education.
